



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD

Voiding Bid for Tire Collection

WHEREAS, in order to receive the most competitive price available, the Will County Executive's Office solicited bids for tire collection between September 2019, to November 2019, and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2019, the Will County Executive's Office opened two (2) proposals, and

WHEREAS, one bid was rejected leaving one qualified bid. After review and consideration, it was determined to void the bid due to exceeding identified funding. Based on the labor costs in the bid, and clarification from the bidder, the Will County Land Use Department, Resource Recovery and Energy Division staff recommend voiding the bid and requests permission to reissue the bid after the bid specifications are redesigned by staff and the Will County Purchasing Department, and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the bid for tire collection be voided and requests permission to reissue the bid, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee concurs with their request.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby voids the bid for tire collection and authorizes staff to work with the Will County State's Attorney and Will County Purchasing Director to redesign the bid specifications and reissue the bid.



Re: Request to Void Tire Bid Proposal
Date: May 20, 2019

On April 25, 2019 two bids were received in response to a request for bids for a Tire Collection Event to be held between September and November of 2019. One bid was rejected due to a missing bid bond. The other bid, submitted by DisposAll, was reviewed by the Will County Land Use Department, Resource Recovery and Energy Division staff.

Under Section 19. Awarding of the Bid: The bid will be awarded after all bids have been received, opened and reviewed, the bid is expected to be approved at the June 20, 2019 meeting of the Will County Board. The lowest responsible bidder will be selected based on the following criteria;

- A. Price;
- B. Location (within Will County)
- C. Reference;
- D. Availability on the proposed dates (Saturdays September-November 2019);
- E. Environmental compliance history; and
- F. Responsiveness to RFP.

Upon review and consideration of the bid, the staff questioned DisposAll on the labor costs of \$12,440.00. The owner responded to an email from staff asking if the labor costs would be less if less tire tonnage was received during the event. The owner stated the labor costs would not change (see email attached).

Based on the labor costs in the bid, and clarification from the bidder, the Will County Land Use Department, Resource Recovery and Energy Division staff recommend voiding the bid and requests permission to reissue the bid after the bid specifications are redesigned by staff and the Will County Purchasing Department.

Does Disposall plan to load tires by hand or by equipment? **We will use equipment. We plan to use a 721 Case Loader**

How many staff will Disposall have on the site during this event? If Will County advertises to residents they must unload their own tires will the labor cost change? **1-Equipment Operator, 2 Laborers, 1-supervisor. There will be no change in labor cost.**

If Disposall plans to have transfer trucks, for the tires, how many trucks will be running during the event? **3 to 4 transfer trailer**

Will the total cost be based on tonnage (196.50/ton) plus labor cost as written in the bid proposal? **Yes**

It appears, based on the cost of transportation, processing and disposal of all tires, Disposall is anticipating 280 tons of tires. Is this correct? **Yes** And if so, if the event brings in 150 tons of tires then the cost will be 29,475 plus labor? **Yes**
