

WHEREAS, the current contract for nursing services allows for two (2), one (1) year renewal options, if the County so chooses, and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director and Sunny Hill Administration have recommended, and the Public Health & Safety Committee has concurred, that the contract for nursing services (CNA, LPN & RN) at Sunny Hill be renewed for an additional year, based upon attached numerous correspondence from all participating nursing vendors, and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations have been budgeted in Sunny Hill's Budget.
