



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD  
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

***Awarding Bid for Household Hazardous Waste Collection***

WHEREAS, the Illinois Solid Waste Planning and Recycling Act mandates counties to plan for the management of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the County's Solid Waste Plan, Will County will provide options to the public for the safe collection and appropriate management and disposal of Household Hazardous Waste when funding is available and in response to program needs; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management, Inc. pursuant to the "Host Agreement and Agreement for Operation/Development of the Will County Landfill" will pay for two (2) household hazardous waste collections per year each spring for the life of the landfill; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2022 the County Executive's Office opened three (3) acceptable bids to provide household hazardous waste collection services, for up to six (6) household hazardous waste collections per year and as needed pharmaceutical waste pickup from the County Warehouse and as needed paint collection supplies drop off or paint pickup at county partner sites for a three (3) year period; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Recovery & Energy Division staff has recommended, and the Executive Committee concurs, that the bid for household hazardous waste collection services be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, Veolia ES Technical Solutions, LLC, East Chicago, IN, for an approximate cost of \$63,297.84 per average event, for a three (3) year period starting June 1, 2022 and ending May 31, 2025; and all costs associated with this agreement will be paid from the Solid Waste Management fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid for the household hazardous waste collection services to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, Veolia ES Technical Solutions, LLC, East Chicago, IN, for an approximate cost of \$63,297.84 per average event, for a three (3) year period starting June 1, 2022 and ending May 31, 2025; and all costs associated with this agreement will be paid from the Solid Waste Management fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.



RE: Recommendation of Household Hazardous Waste Contractor

In keeping with the Will County Solid Waste Management Plan approved by the Will County Board, the County will provide options to the public for the safe collection, appropriate management, and disposal of Household Hazardous Waste when funding is available and in response to program needs. Furthermore, pursuant to the "Host Agreement and Agreement for Operation/Development of the Will County Landfill" with Waste Management, Waste Management will pay for two Household Hazardous Waste Collection events each spring for the life of the Landfill Agreement. Therefore, the County conducts a minimum of two household hazardous waste collection events per year and may conduct up to six events per year. Historically, the County has conducted three to six events each of the last 20 years.

As part of the bid, the County requested additional services such as the delivery of supplies, costs for those supplies, and the removal of residentially generated hazardous waste from County designated locations. The Resource Recovery and Energy Division requested the Purchasing Department to issue RFB's for the purpose of selecting a contractor to provide the outlined services once executed. The contract period for Household Hazardous Waste Collection and related services will be from June 1, 2022 until May 31, 2025.

The County received acceptable bids from Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. and Veolia ES Technical Solutions, LLC. The County also received a bid from Tradebe Environmental Services, LLC, that was disqualified per States Attorney's Office for submitting a contract rider, as part of their bid proposal document, requesting to change the minimum insurance limits contingent on bid acceptance. Please see the attached documents for a breakdown of our evaluation and cost comparison. The contractors that bid were evaluated on Proposal Content, Service Abilities, Technical Requirements, Availability, Liability Protection, Financial Responsibility & Compliance

\*\* Veolia did not submit a bid for Latex Paint Recycling. Latex Paint Fuel Blending submitted by all contractros, therefore costs for Latex Paint Fuel Blending were utilized for this comparison. Furthermore, Latex Paint Fuel Blending would be preferred over Latex Paint Solidification and Disposal by County, since Fuel Blending would be considered by the County to be more beneficial to the environmen

\*\*\* Veolia submitted a "NO BID" for old/unused medications disposal for a 30-gal drum. 15-gal drum costs submitted by all contractors, therefore 15-gal drum costs were utilized for this comparison. Veolia submitted "NO BID" for disposal of Toxic Solids in cubic Yard box. 55-gal drum costs submitted by all contractors, therefore 55-gal drum costs were utilized for this comparison. Furthermore, while collection container volumes were adjusted the over all volume collected remains the same.

Notes:

- The bid with the lowest disposal costs when applied to the average amount of household hazardous wastes received at County events as listed within Attachment D of the Request For Proposals received the maximum number of points. Bids with disposal costs higher than the low bid were deducted award points based on the percentage above the low bid. For example, a bid 10% higher than the lowest bid would be deducted 3.5 award points, a bid 50% higher than the lowest bid would be deducted 17.5 award points, a bid 100% or more higher than the lowest bid would be deducted all award points.
- The bid with the lowest mobilization cost per average County event as listed in Attachment D of the Request For Proposals received the maximum number of award points. Bids with costs higher than the low bid were deducted award points based on the percentage above the low bid. For example, a bid 10% higher than the lowest bid would be deducted 2.5 award points, a bid 50% higher than the lowest bid would be deducted 12.5 award points, a bid 100% or more higher than the lowest bid would be deducted all award points.
- As part of bid submittal packet applicant signed Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Program Agreement agreeing to the county's terms of Minimum Limits of Insurance as stated in Section 9.3. However, no example was provided for review.

**Rider to Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Program Agreement**

The terms of this Rider ("Rider") are incorporated in the Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Program Agreement ("Agreement"). The terms of this Rider control over any contrary provision in the Agreement. Unless otherwise stated in this Rider, capitalized terms used in this Rider have the meaning given to those terms in the Agreement.

1. The umbrella liability coverage requirement is changed from "at least fourteen million dollars (\$14,000,000) per occurrence" to "at least ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) per occurrence". In addition, Contractor will provide Contractors Pollution Liability coverage of at least fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) per condition and in the aggregate, which coverage includes waste transportation.
2. Eligible Participants are not required to be named as additional insureds.
3. In Section 10.1 (Indemnification) of the Agreement, the sentence beginning with "The foregoing indemnity" is replaced by the following:

"The foregoing indemnity shall apply except to the extent such injury, death or damage is caused by the negligent acts or omissions of an indemnified person or party."

4. Neither party shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, indirect, special or punitive damages.
