



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

Awarding Bid for Body Armor for Sheriff's Department

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Will County's Sheriff's Department to be equipped and ready for dangerous situations; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the most competitive rates for body armor, proposals were solicited; and

WHEREAS, on March 24th, the County Executive's Office opened five (5) proposals for the purchase of body armor; and

WHEREAS, after intense review, the Sheriff's Department has recommended to go with the lowest responsible bidder of Ray O'Herron Co. Inc, Danville, IL. This is an approximate annual amount of \$76,500.00 for the purchase of +/- 50 Enforcement Officer vests per year at a cost of \$680.00 each and +/- 50 Correctional / Court Security Officer vests per year at a cost of \$850.00 each. This will be a three (3) year contract, effective June 1, 2022, through and including May 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee has concurred with this recommendation, with necessary funding available in the Sheriff's Budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the contract to provide body armor for the Sheriff's Department to the lowest responsible bidder of Ray O'Herron Co. Inc, Danville, IL. This is an approximate annual amount of \$76,500.00 for the purchase of +/- 50 Enforcement Officer vests per year at a cost of \$680.00 each and +/- 50 Correctional / Court Security Officer vests per year at a cost of \$850.00 each. This will be a three (3) year contract, effective June 1, 2022 through and including May 31, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

Upon reviewing the submitted bids (Contract for #2022-23 Sheriff Body Armor) and/or completing our testing, we have enclosed our recommendation. Please see below for further.

JCM Uniform, Inc.: (Survival Armor)

Enforcement (Paladin Model #ULW-II and Flacon Flex Model # FC-FEM-II)

Meets all requirements.

Corrections (Cancelable Combination Armor Model # B2S2)

Meets all requirements.

Ray O'Herron Co., Inc. (Point Blank)

Enforcement (BII-5 Level II)

Stated in paragraph 6 of the Technical Specifications- Enforcement Officers: "Backface signature: Armor model must have an average 9mm new and .357 magnum new,

backface signature below 35mm. Documentation must be provided with bid.” Included documentation shows that the “New .357 Mag” has a backface (BF) higher than 35mm.

Corrections. (Ballistic-Spike Combo Model # CB-S2-BII-1)

Based on review of the enclosed documents submitted with the bid's we found that all submitted Ballistic and Ballistic/Stab Resistant vest had required paperwork. We have reviewed both vest types that were submitted and are satisfied with the results for all except for the Point Blank for Enforcement. See above.

Both Ray O'Herron Co. Inc. and The Cop Fire Shop Inc. submitted bids for the Armor Express Model Vortex Gen II vest and the Gemini Dual Purpose Armor. Ray O'Herron Co. Inc. quoted a lower price than The Cop Fire Shop Inc. by \$180.00 for the Enforcement vest and \$285.00 for the Corrections/Court Security Officer vest.

Therefore, for the Enforcement Division we would like to purchase the Armor Express (Vortex Gen II) and for the Corrections Division/Court Security Officers Division (Gemini Dual Purpose Armor) we would like to purchase the Armor Express (Gemini Dual Purpose Armor) through Ray O'Herron Co. Inc.
